I am pleased to present the eighth edition of Rwanda's Tax Statistics Report, reaffirming the Rwanda Revenue Authority's (RRA) commitment to transparency, evidence-based policymaking, and effective communication of tax data. This edition provides an in-depth analysis of tax performance, compliance, and trade trends for the fiscal year 2024/25, offering a clearer picture of Rwanda's evolving tax landscape.

This year's report introduces new Comprehensive International Trade Indicators featuring Cost, Insurance, and Freight (CIF) and Free on Board (FOB) analyses that highlight the number of importers and exporters and their trade values across brackets.

Additionally, the Gross Domestic Product (GDP) figures have been updated using the rebased national accounts released by the National Institute of Statistics of Rwanda (NISR) which use 2024 as the new reference year, ensuring that the macroeconomic context accurately reflects Rwanda's most recent structural and price-level adjustments. This update allows for improved comparability between revenue performance and overall economic activity.

The fiscal year 2024/25 continued to witness steady growth in domestic revenue collection, supported by ongoing digital

transformation, data analytics adoption, and enhanced taxpayer engagement. Initiatives such as the Value Added Tax (VAT) Reward Scheme and the Voluntary Disclosure Scheme have strengthened compliance culture and broadened the tax base.

As we move forward, RRA remains steadfast in its mission to build a modern, transparent, and inclusive tax administration. Through continuous innovation and collaboration with stakeholders, we aim to sustain revenue growth, foster taxpayer trust, and contribute effectively to Rwanda's national development goals. Previous editions of the Tax Statistics Report are available for reference on the RRA website at www.rra.gov.rw.

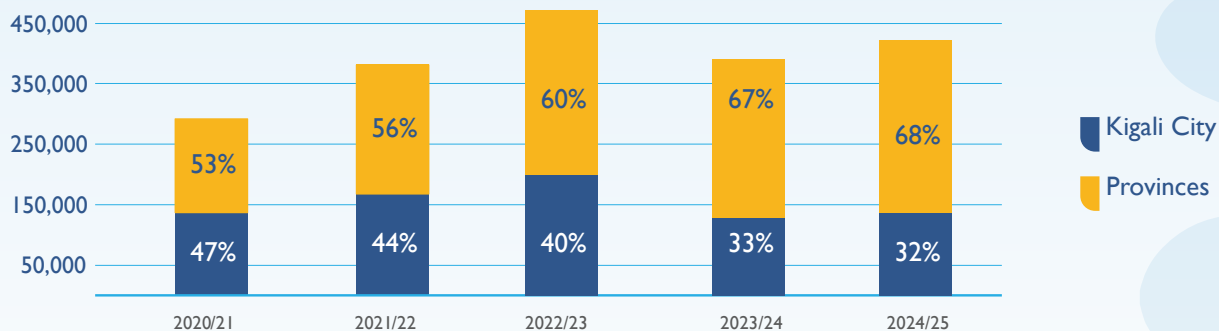

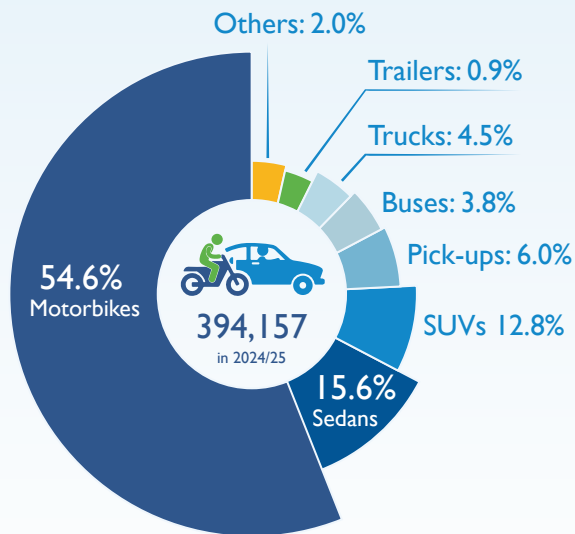

1.5. VAT REGISTERED TAXPAYERS: EBM VS. NON-EBM

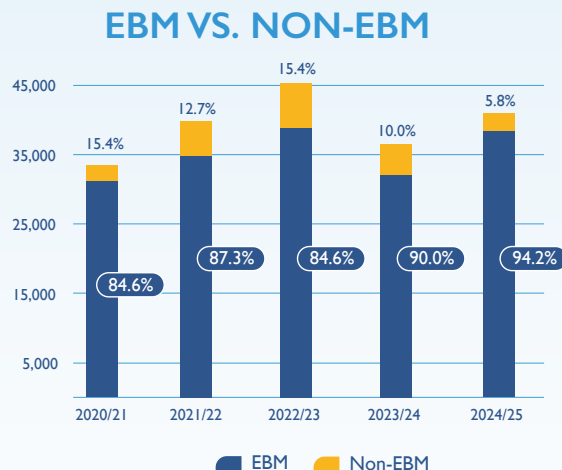

VAT TAXPAYERS WITH EBM (%)

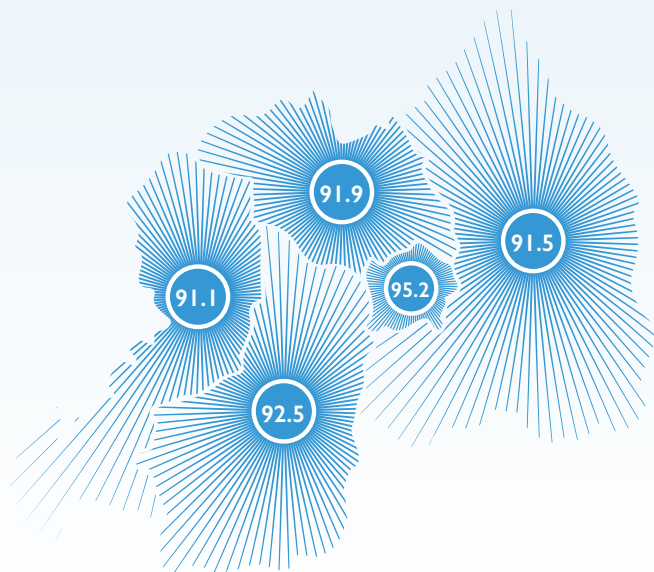

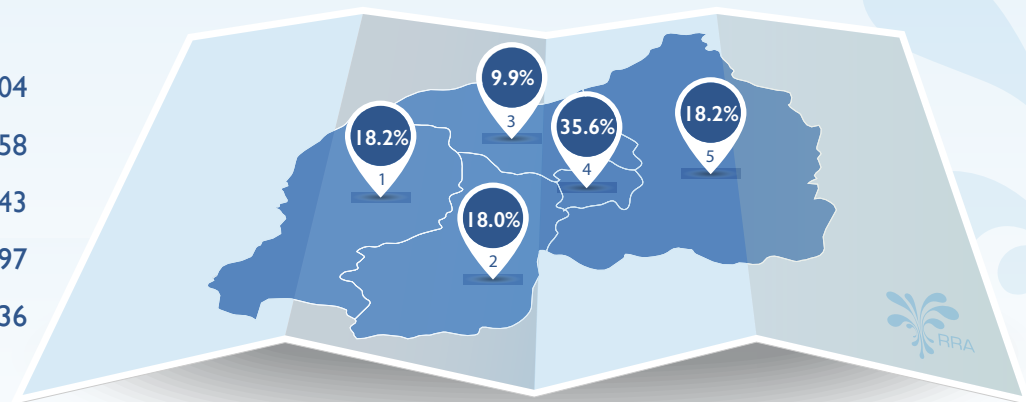

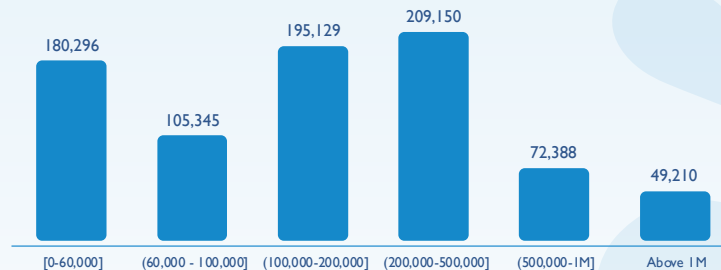

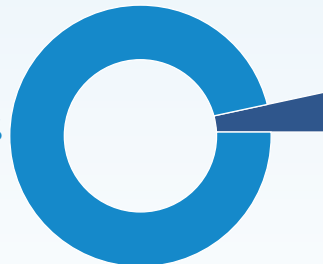

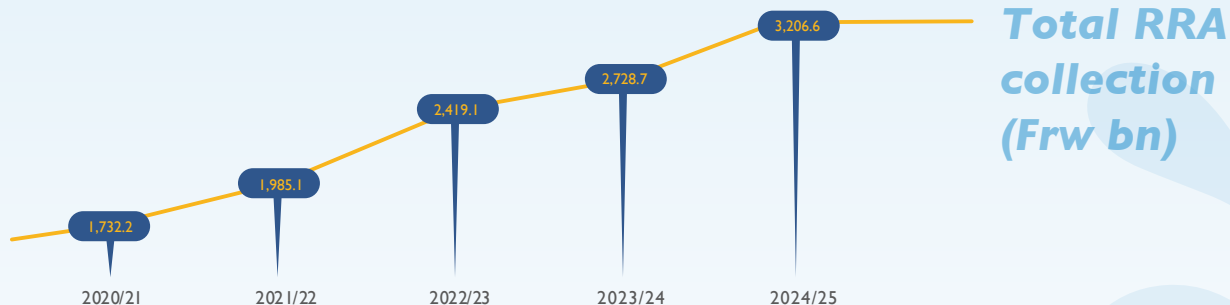

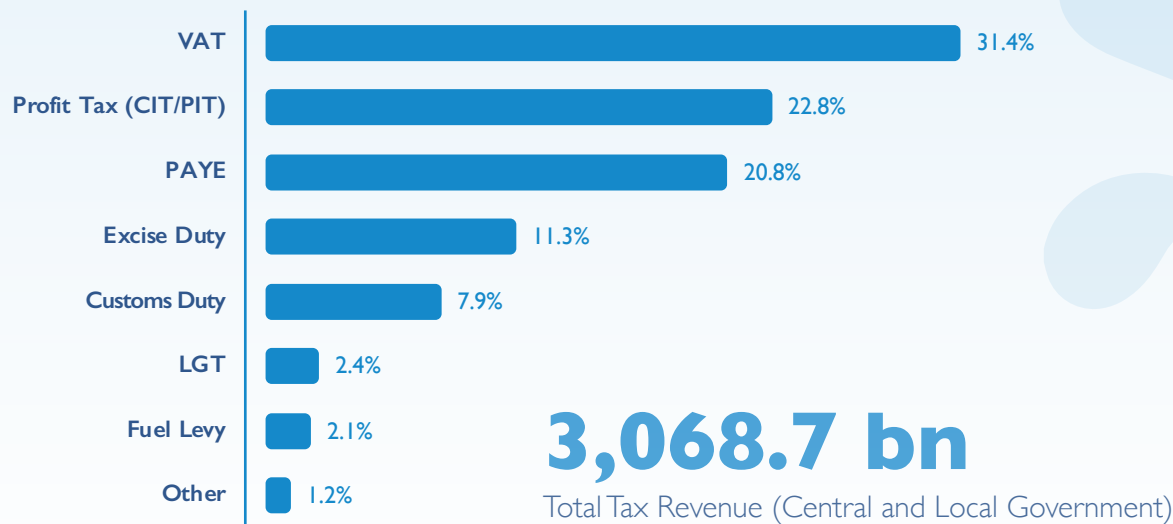

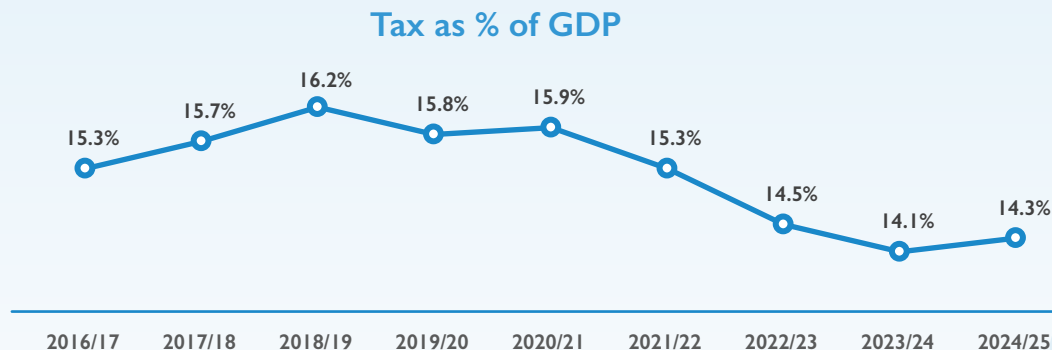

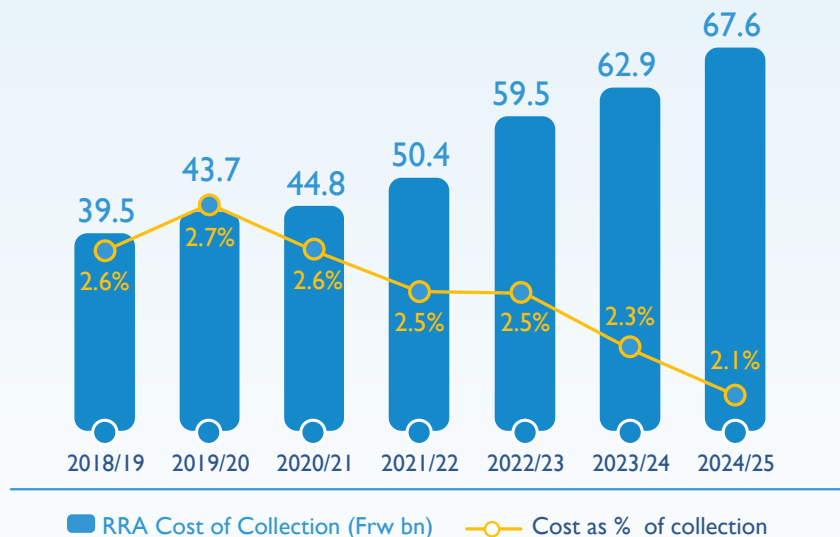

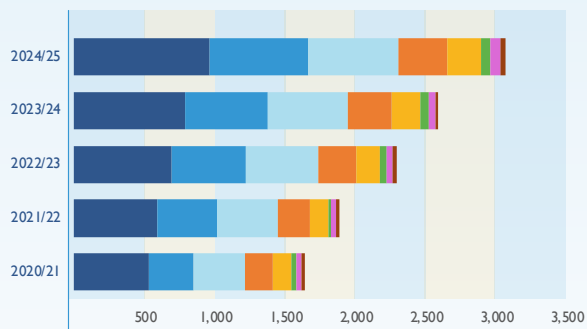

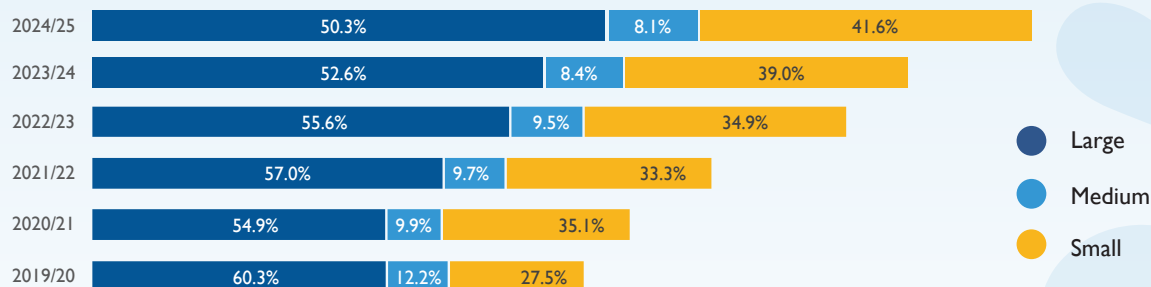

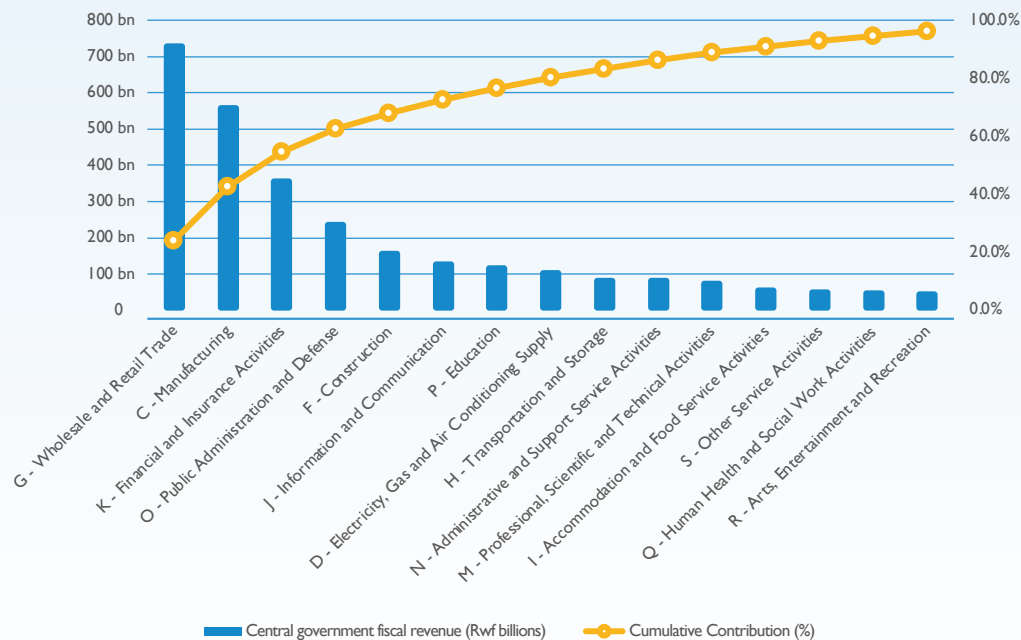

B. TOP 15 SECTORS BY CONTRIBUTION TO CENTRAL GOVERNMENT FISCAL REVENUE (2024/25)



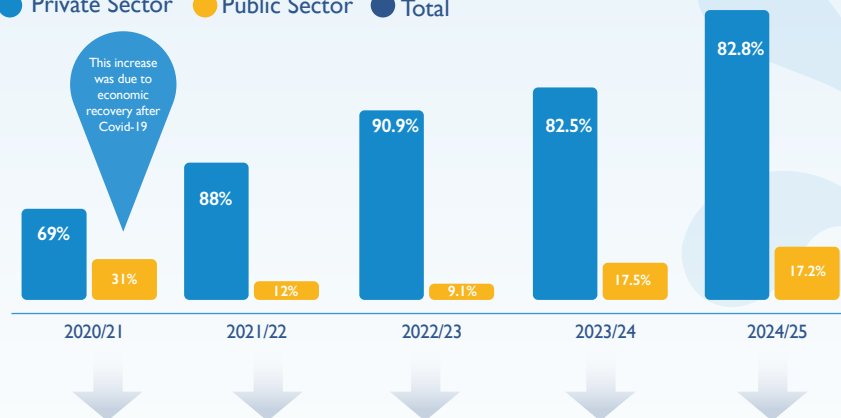
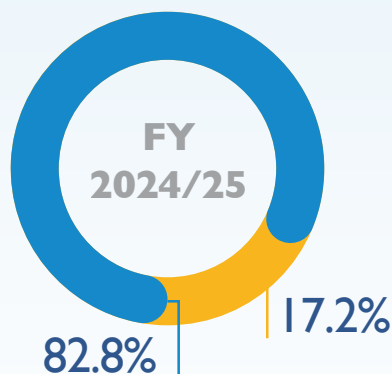

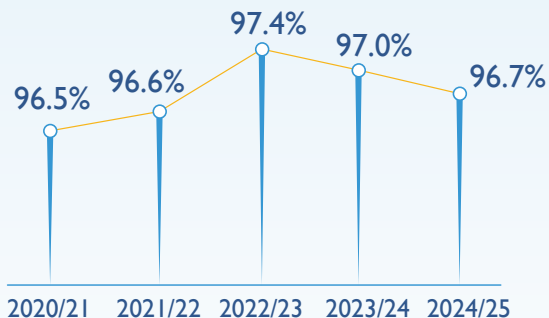

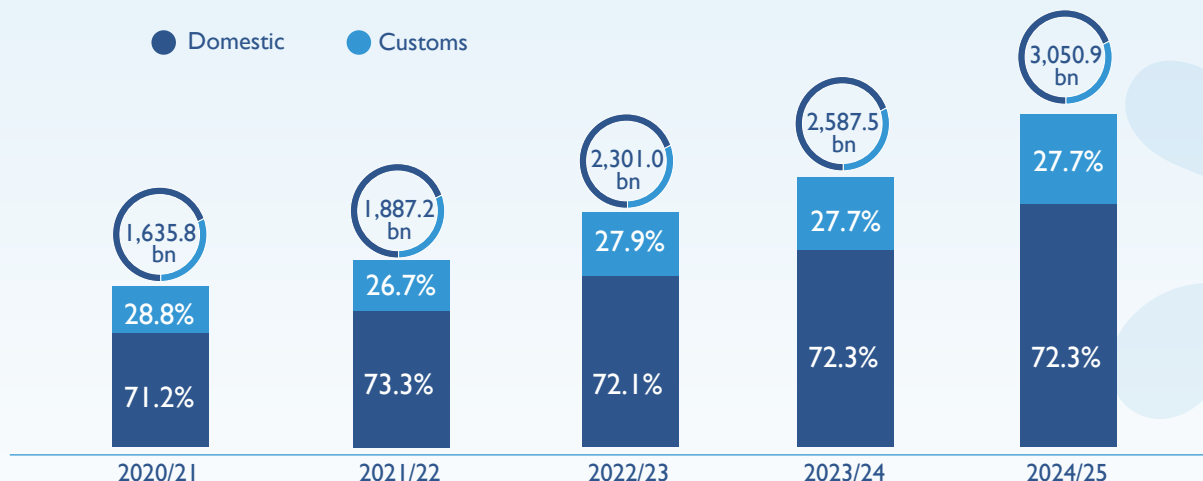

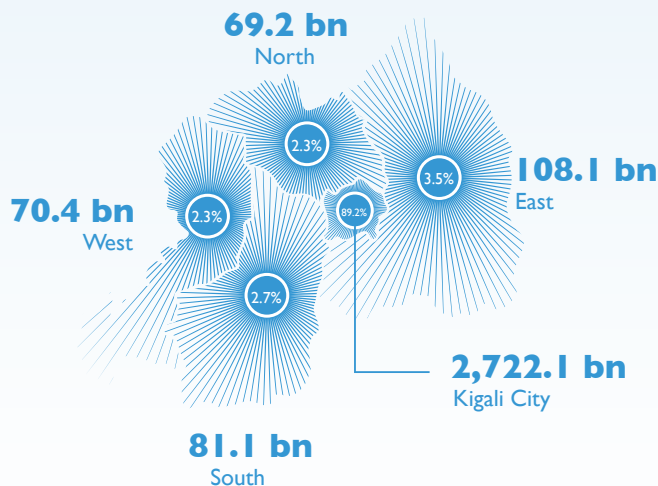

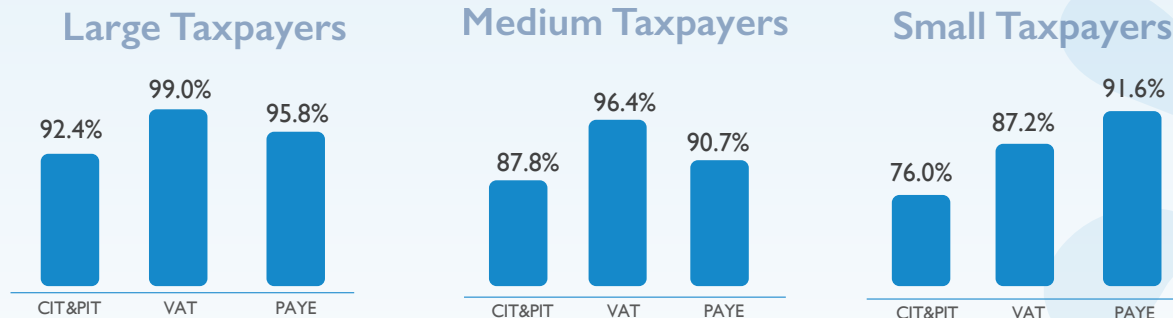

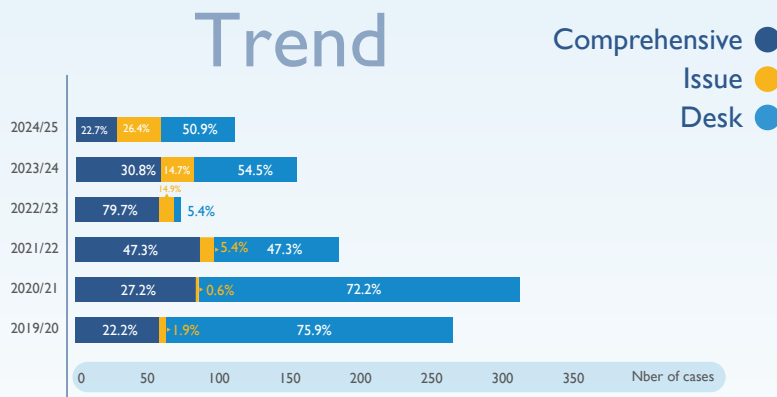

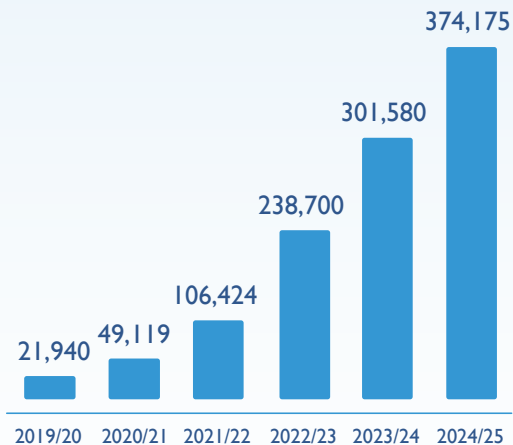

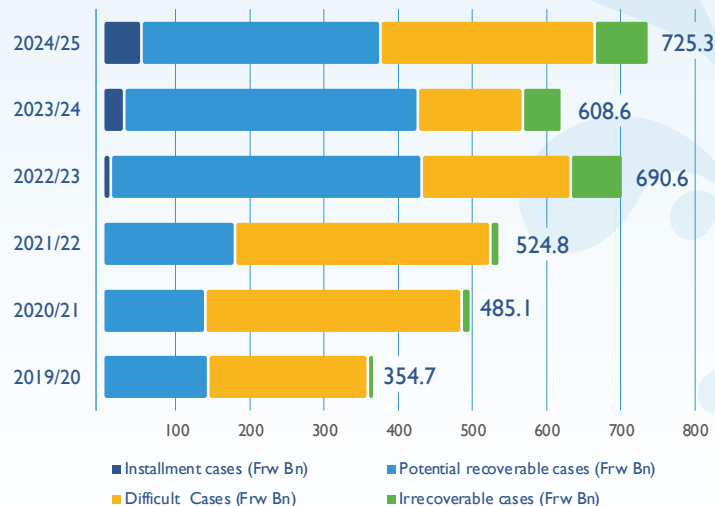

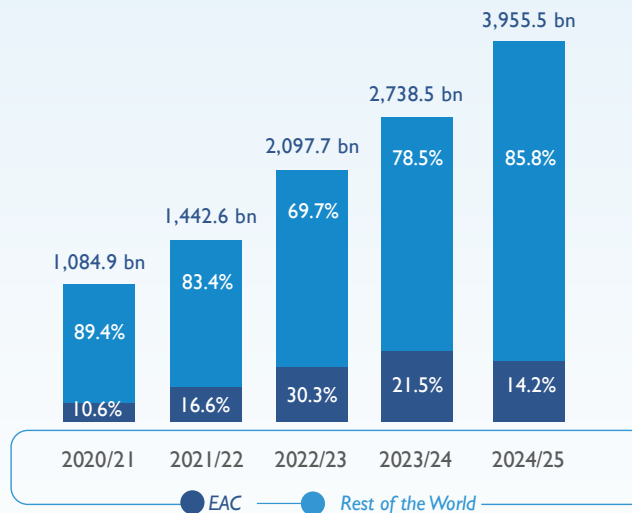

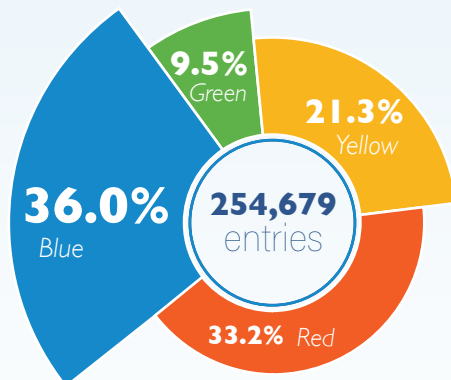

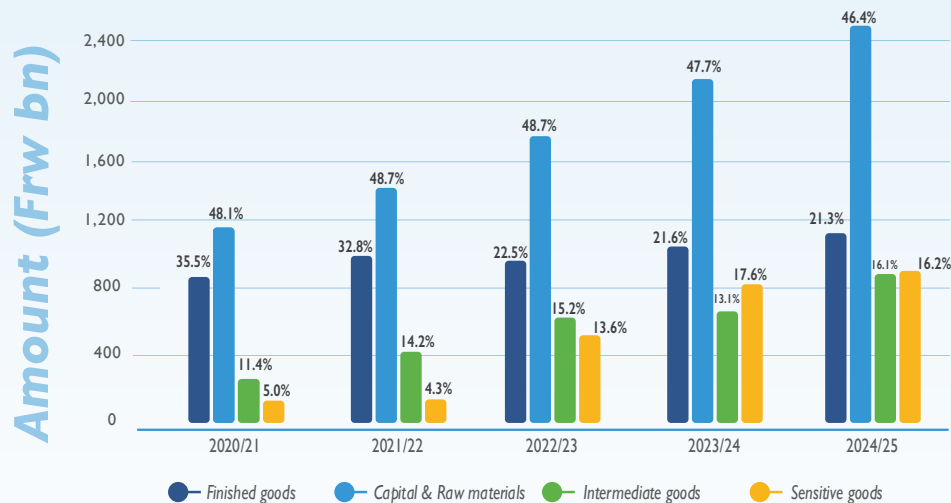

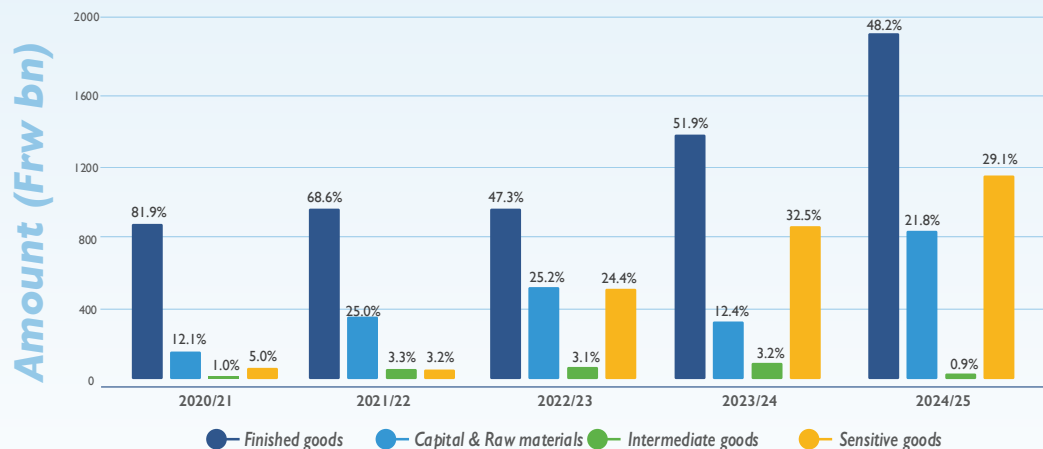

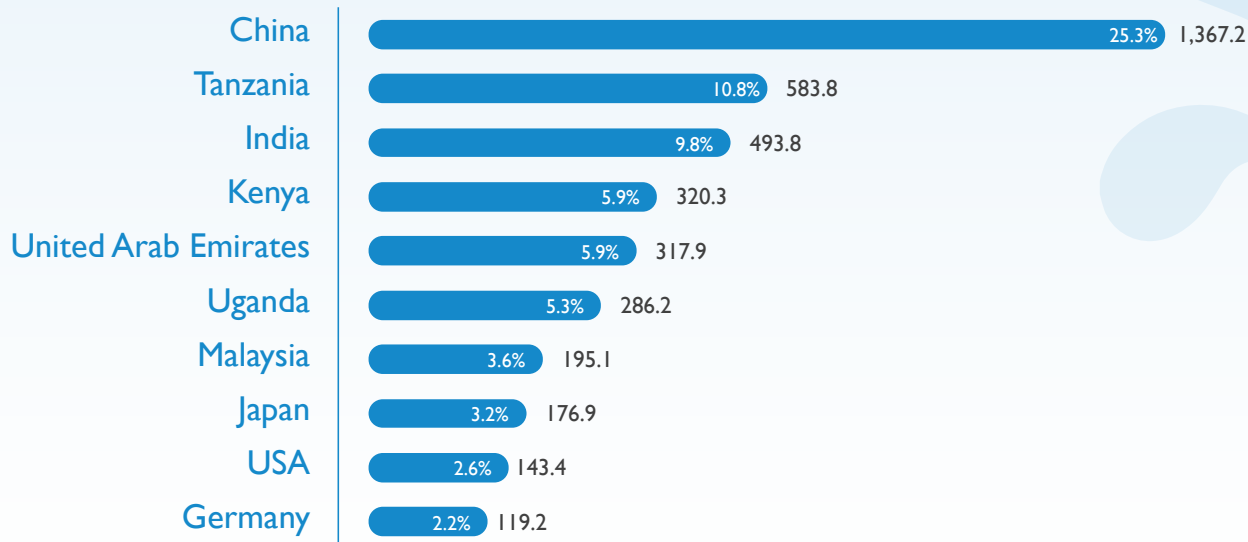

TOP 10 COUNTRIES OF ORIGIN FOR IMPORTS IN FY 2024/25

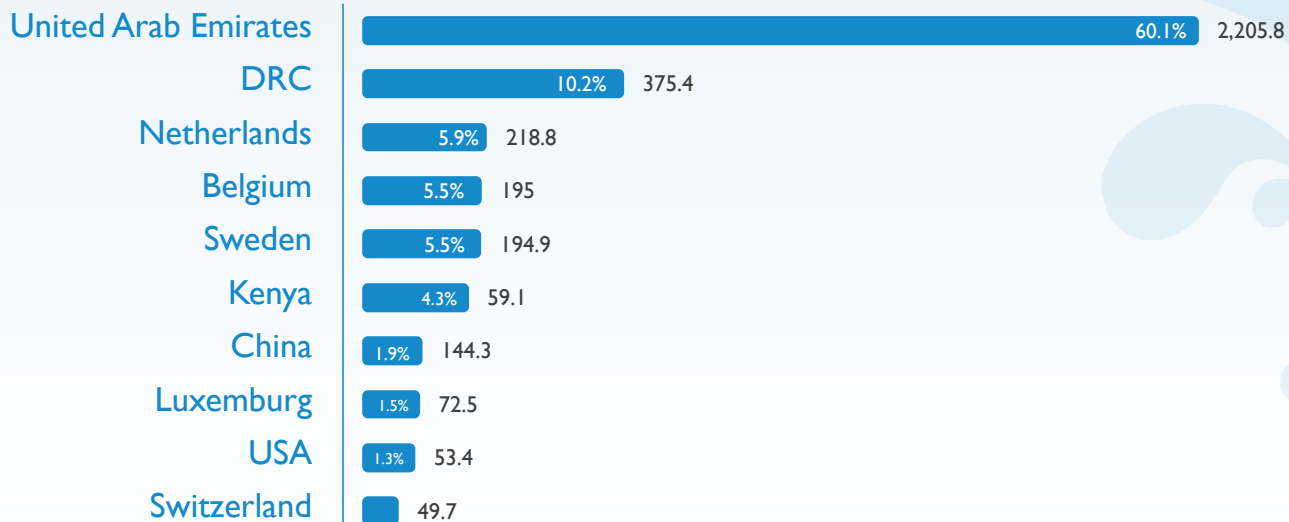

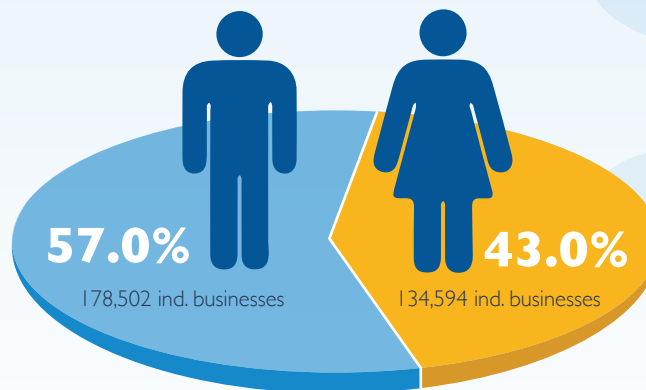

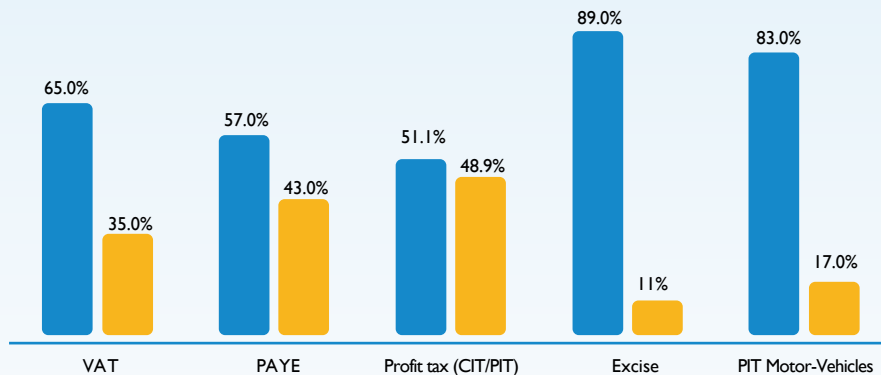

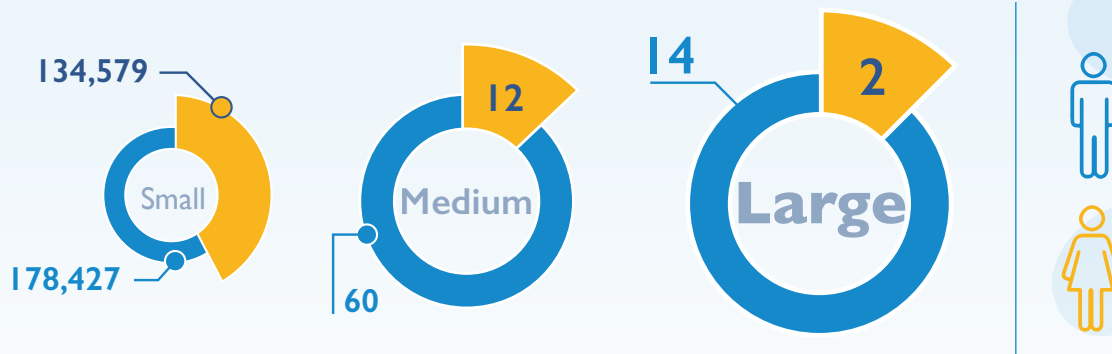

REVENUE COLLECTION BY INDIVIDUAL BUSINESS OWNERSHIP GENDER

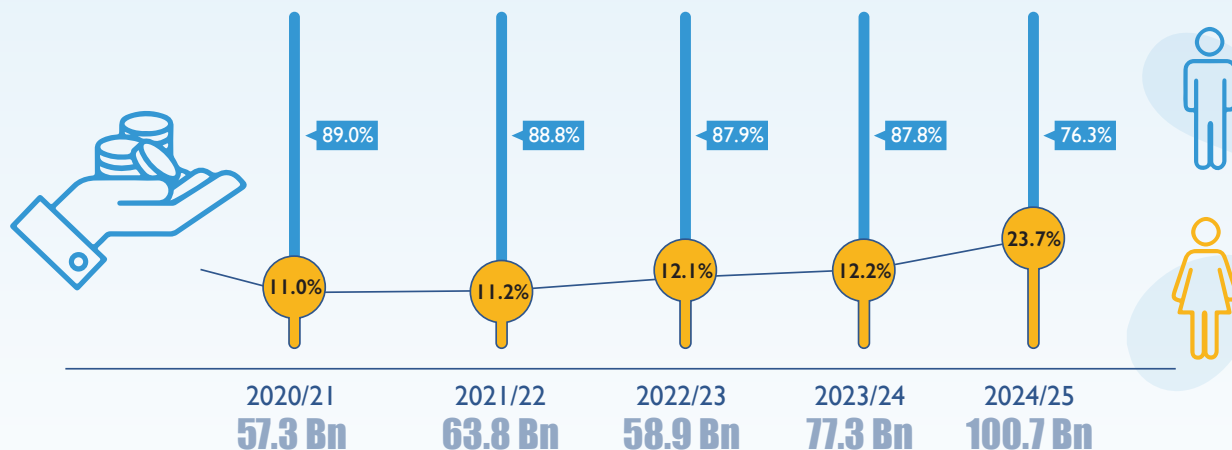

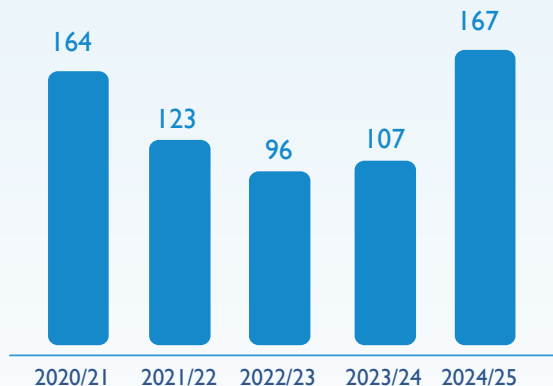

Number of female exporters

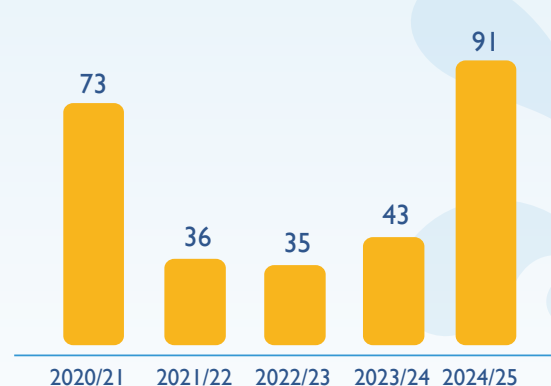

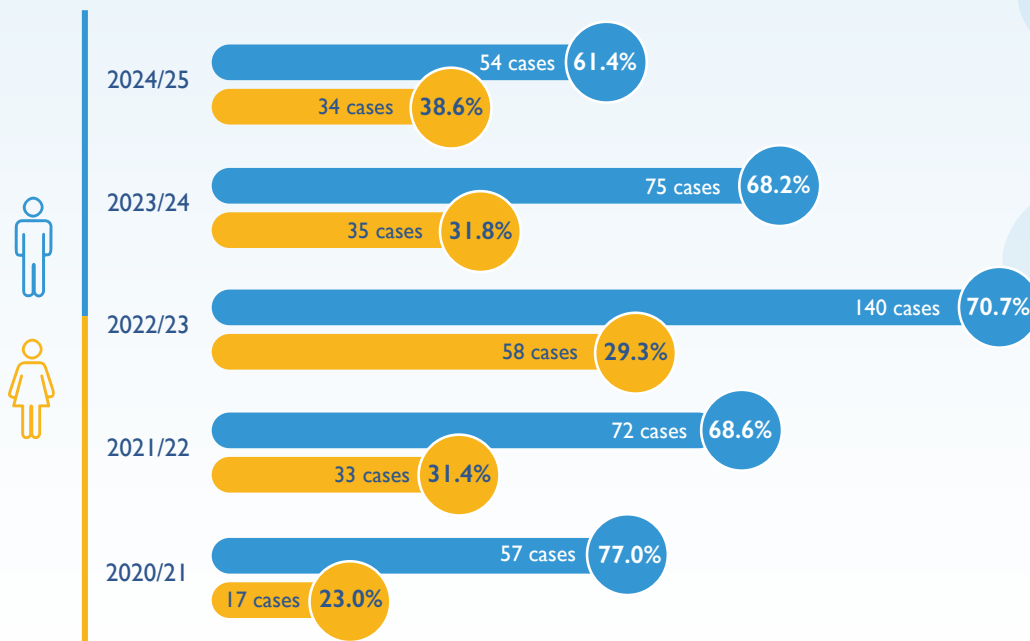

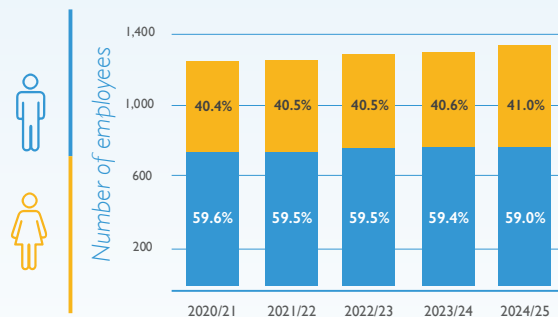

RRA EMPLOYEES IN CENTRAL TAX ADMINISTRATION BY GENDER

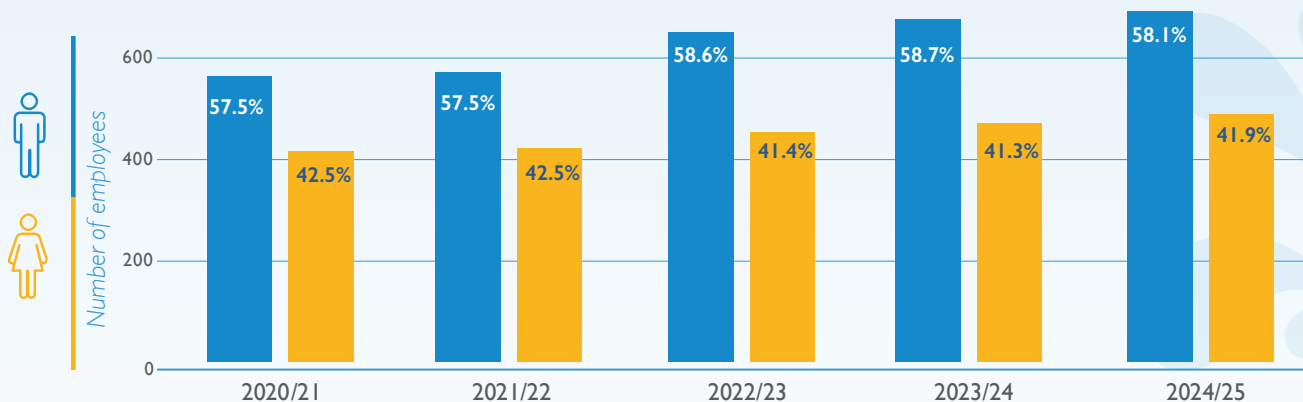

RRA EMPLOYEES IN DECENTRALIZED TAX ADMINISTRATION BY GENDER

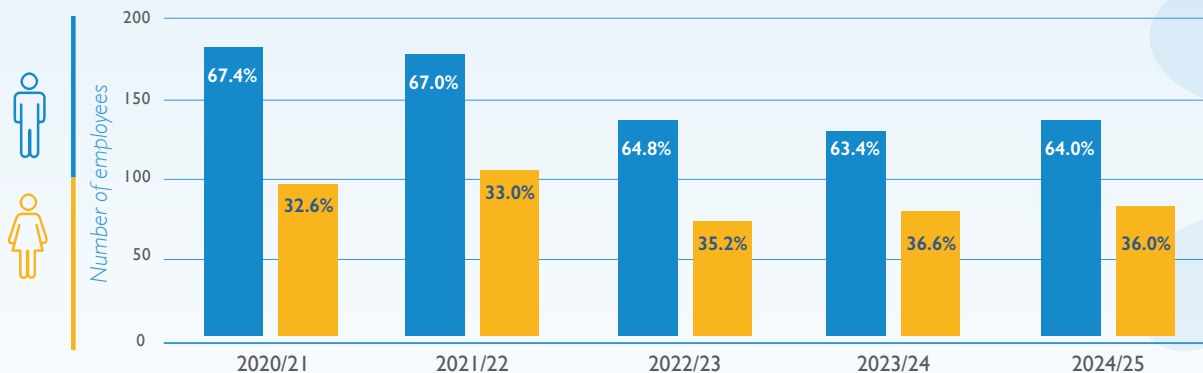

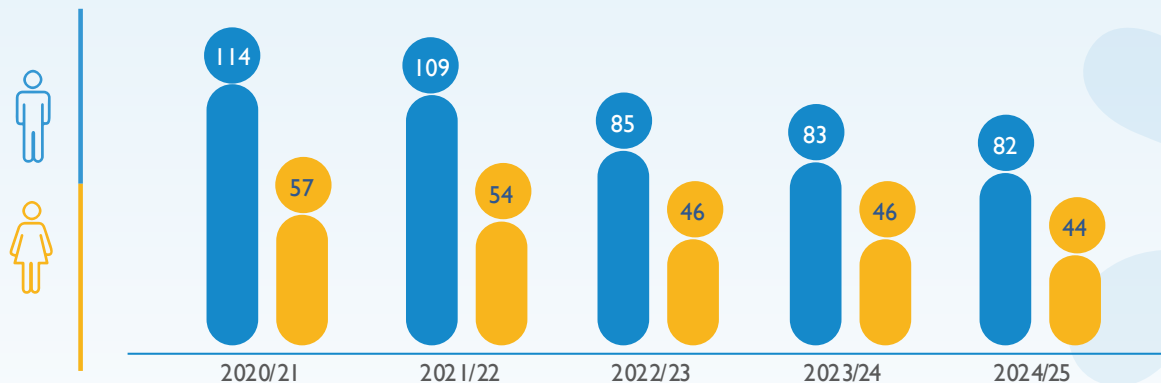


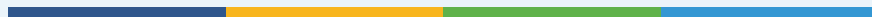
