ITANGAZO

Bimaze kugaragara ko hari abacuruzi binangiye bakaba bakomeje kudatanga inyemezabuguzi za EBM cyangwa abahitishamo umuguzi kumuha cyangwa kutamuha inyemezabuguzi ya EBM;

RRA iramenyesha abacuruzi n'abaguzi ko uwo muco ugomba gucika burundu mu Rwanda. Ni muri urwo rwego ingamba zikurikira zafashwe:

1. Umuguzi wese udafite inyemezabuguzi ya EBM yaguriyeho ibicuruzwa afite, ibyo bicuruzwa bizajya bifatwa bitezwe cyamunara;
2. Umucuruzi wese uzafatwa yacurujye atatanze inyemezabuguzi ya EBM, a. azacibwa ibihano; b. Hazakorwa ubugenzuzi bw'ububiko bw'ibicuruzwa bye kugira ngo ibyo yacurujye byose atabitangiye inyemezabuguzi abicirirwe umusoro byose; c. Azakurikiranwa mu butabera ku cyaha cyo kunyereza umusoro abigambiriye; d. Ubucuruzi bwe buzafungwa mu gihe cy'iminsi mirongo itatu (30);
3. Abantu bose bakorewe inyandiko-mvugo imenyesha icyaha cyo gucuruza udatanga inyemezabuguzi ya EBM cyangwa atanga itubya umusoro ndetse bakanatangazwa mu bitangazamakuru, barasabwa kuba bamaze kwishyura amande baciwe bitarenze kuwa mbere tariki 28/11/2022. Abatazabyubahiriza bazafungirwa ubucuruzi kubera ko bacurujye batubahiriza amategeko.

Ku bindi bisobanuro, mwaduhamagara ku murongo utishyurwa 3004.

ANNOUNCEMENT

Pursuant to the evidences proving that there are merchants who resisted issuing electronic receipts (EBM receipts) or those who present to the buyer an option of issuing the receipt or not;

RRA informs all merchants and buyers that such malpractices must stop in Rwanda going forward. Hence, the following measures have been put in place:

1. Every buyer whose purchases are not supported by EBM receipt, those goods will be seized and auctioned;
2. Every merchant who will be caught not issuing EBM receipt on every sale will: a. be charged with fines and/or penalties; b. be liable to a stock analysis in order to find out all goods that were sold without issuing EBM receipts in order to recover all taxes evaded; c. be prosecuted in the court of law for planned tax evasion d. His/her business will be closed for thirty days (30);
3. All merchants who received a statement of offense for non-issuance of EBM receipt or understating the price of the product on the receipt and were published in media, are required to pay their penalties by Monday 28th November 2022. Businesses of those who will not have paid by this deadline will be closed for non-compliance to the provisions of the law.
