







































INDIVIDUAL BUSINESSES OWNERSHIP BY GENDER







REVENUE COLLECTION BY INDIVIDUAL TAXPAYERS & BY GENDER





6. INDIVIDUAL EXPORTERS BY GENDER









NUMBER OF FEMALE AND MALE MANAGERS IN THE TAX ADMINISTRATION




