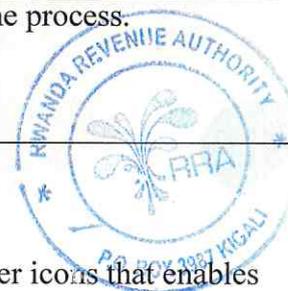


USER GUIDE FOR TAX PROFESSIONAL APPLICATION FOR LICENCE

NO	Process	Action
1	Accessing the System	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Open the link (https://tpms.rra.gov.rw) provided by the tax administration. ➤ The system will load the Applicant Registration Page.
2	Creating an Account	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Enter your TIN (Tax Identification Number) in the designated field. ➤ Click Verify. ➤ The system will automatically display your registered information. ➤ Review your information, if doesn't match with your current information update information from RRA /RDB registration office ➤ Create your Password following the required rules. ➤ Click Create Account to complete registration.
3	Logging In	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Click Login on the main page. ➤ Enter your TIN and Password. ➤ Click Login to access your dashboard and ➤ IF forgot password click forgot password on then login page
4	Starting the License Application Process	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ On the dashboard, click Apply Here to start the process.
5	Uploading Required Documents	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Upload each required document. ➤ Click Upload → Select File from your device. ➤ Confirm each upload ➤ On the upload section there are three more other icons that enables the applicant to View Edit, and delete
6	Submitting the Application	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ After uploading all documents, Submit Application.
7	Receiving Confirmation	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ You will receive an on-screen confirmation message. (your application has been successfully submitted) ➤ You will also receive a confirmation or rejection email after review of your application. On the registered email in the period of 30days
If Rejected		
8	Re –Apply (Three working days)	<p>The applicant will receive an email notification containing:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ The rejection letter. ➤ The reasons for rejection. ➤ A list of missing or incorrect documents that must be updated. ➤ The system will automatically enable the Re-Apply button for three (3) calendar days from the date of rejection. ➤ After logging in, the applicant will see a Re-Application alert on their dashboard.
9	Reviewing the Rejection Letter	<p>The applicant must download and read the rejection letter. The missing requirements will be clearly indicated in bullet points for easy understanding.</p>





10	Updating Missing or Incorrect Documents	The applicant will: Click Re-Apply . Access the previously submitted information. Locate all fields or document sections marked in red colour, they are the missing Documents and click to update Upload the updated documents.
11	Tracking Application Status	• Log in anytime to view your application progress under Application Status.
