#### Minutes of the meeting

The meeting of the Tax Policy Committee was held on Thursday October 1<sup>st</sup>, 2015 in the boardroom of the office of Government Chief Economist. The meeting started at 3:00 PM and was chaired by Mrs. Amina U. RWAKUNDA- the Senior Economist in MINECOFIN and the chairperson of the Tax Policy Committee. The meeting started with the chairperson welcoming new members namely; Mr. Fred KAREMERA who replaced Mr. Joseph MPUNGA in RDB, and Mrs. Germaine MUKABARISA who replaced Mrs. Christine NYIRANSHIMIYIMANA in MINICOM.

## MEETING DISCUSSION AND DECISIONS:

## 1. Consideration of ICT and Education equipment to be exempted from VAT:

The list was not ready for discussion and the meeting referred the matter to the next TPC Meeting.

2. Consideration of additional list of agricultural inputs and other agricultural and livestock materials and equipment to be exempted as per new VAT law:

The list was approved with amendments (MINAGRI experts were requested to add distinctive specifications to some equipment on the list that are not solely for irrigation purposes to limit possible abuses by importers).

## 3. The Legal status of Tax Policy Committee:

The meeting referred this agenda item to the next TPC meeting after legal consultations.

## 4. Hardship waiver of penalties and interest for taxpayers recommended by RRA:

After assessing the basis for each taxpayer's request, the meeting waived off fines and interests for the following taxpayers:

- a) L & M Civil and Electrical Engineering
- b) FERWAFA
- c) MUKAMURIGO Madeleine
- d) University of Tourism, Technology and Business Studies
- e) COMVIVA Technologies

The meeting discussed but did not approve waiver request for Rwanda Biomedical Centre because it lacked a clear basis, but RRA promised to refile the request after a review.

#### 5. Any other Business

## a) Application of new Investment Code;

On this item, RDB representative enlightened the meeting about the current challenges in implementing new investment code especially issues related to management of exemptions, duty remissions, acquired rights and monitoring of macroeconomic impact of incentivised investment projects to the economy.



The meeting recommended that RDB organize a retreat bringing together all relevant institutions to agree on joint strategy and the role of each institution in the application of new investment code.

## b) Other emerging proposals in amendment of Law relating income Tax:

The meeting reviewed the proposal from Financial Sector, to exempt withholding tax on interest payable to foreign development lending institutions which are exempted from income tax (for example Development Banks). The meeting recommended that the proposal be included in the Draft Income Tax Law.

# c) Application of VAT exemption on imported and locally produced goods and services.

The meeting exchanged views on the issue, and noted that VAT exemptions are meant to equally apply to both imported goods and locally produced goods as by WTO principle.

The meeting also requested RRA to use all possible channels to publish to the reach of many Rwandans the approved lists of VAT exempted items. On this matter, PSF agreed to support RRA in publication of those lists through its commercial chambers.

The meeting closed at 5pm.
